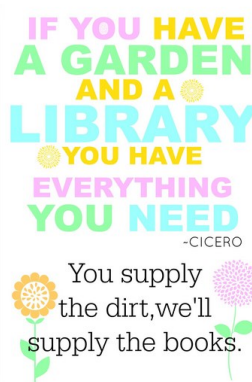

Cricut Cutting Machine



The library purchased a Cricut cutting machine with money received from Walmart last year. It is available for the public to use free of charge. You must bring your own material (vinyl, cardstock...) you wish to cut, the library does not supply the material.

1. Design your project at home. Download Cricut Design Space onto your computer and make your own account. Then design your project. (some designs may be free and some you may need to purchase).
2. Print your project at the library. Bring the material you are using with your design (vinyl, cardstock...) Ask at the front desk to use the Cricut. Log into your account and cut.

What can you make? Iron-on for T-shirts, cards, stencils for wooden signs, removable wall decorations...

Grants received in 2018

Woman's Giving—gave the library \$100 to help with the cost of story time at Growing Patch Learning Center, our local day care. With this money we purchased a cart to carry story time supplies to the daycare and craft supplies.

Jasper Foundation—gave the library \$2959. This money and \$1000 from the Friends of the Library purchased a new book drop.

Walmart—gave the library \$1300 which will be used for the library's teens.

REMC—gave the library \$1975 to fund the Curiosity Dome on June 8th from 10am-5pm.

Friends of the Library—gave the library \$2300 and purchased the kids summer reading prizes (~\$700). \$1000 was spent on the new book drop. The rest is in a fund to use as needed.
